Aboriginal Cultural Immersion Programs

Yarrabin Cultural Connections (YCC) can provide Cultural Awareness, Competence and Safety programs to a broad range of audiences including school groups, universities, government departments and the private sector. We offer students, staff and managers a tailor-made program in introducing or enhancing their Aboriginal cultural education. These can be either one- or two-day programs, depending upon the needs of the participants.

Our Cultural Immersion Programs are delivered primarily outdoors in the natural environment. This provides for experiential learning where participants will use all their senses to gain an appreciation of the Aboriginal cultural connection to land. This connection is the basis to Aboriginal spirituality and identity that provides for a greater understanding of Aboriginal people and culture.

Our aim will be to create a greater awareness of Aboriginal people as having the longest continuous living culture on earth. Participants will complete the program more informed about the history of Aboriginal people in Australia and the impacts of colonisation that are still felt to this day. They will also feel empowered and inspired to thinking about how they can play their part in meaningful engagement with Aboriginal people both at a personal and professional capacity.
